as Guest Workers at NRC Laboratories

The People's Republic of China has expressed an interest in placing scientists and possibly technicians, in Canadian research establishments. The Management Committee has asked the TSC to identify laboratory interest in housing these Chinese scientists.

The host Division would be required to provide laboratory space, but the salary and living expenses of the guest worker would be provided by the People's Republic of China.
